Our collections for the year ended June 30, 2021 are almost exactly what they were as of June 30, 2020 and both years exceeded collections as of June 30, 2019.

We are also so proud of our parish schools. St. Rose High School and Grammar School have maintained and increased enrollment! We celebrated the 100th Anniversary of St. Rose Grammar School in October with a gala celebration and we look forward to doing the same for St. Rose High School in 2023!






#### **OUR MISSION STATEMENT**
